

Hilton East Policy for Visitation during COVID-19

Policy:

It is the policy of Hilton East to adhere to all guidelines provided by New York State and the Federal Government during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Procedure:

Hilton East will permit visitors to residents during COVID-19 provided that the following conditions are adhered to:

Visitors must be 18 years or older or accompanied by an adult
Adequate staff is present to assist with the transition of residents, monitoring of visitation, and cleaning and disinfecting the visitation areas after each visit

2 VISITORS PER RESIDENT PERMITTED PER TIME

Hilton East will post conspicuous signage regarding protocols for face mask utilization, hand hygiene practice, and social distancing expectations while visiting. Cues and markings will be adequately placed in visiting areas for social distancing delineations.

All visitors must agree to be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to resident access. The screening will consist of:

- A completed COVID-19 screening questionnaire
- Hand sanitation
- Temperature is taken and logged
- Signed acknowledgment for Hilton East's Policy on Visitation during COVID-19

Any person unwilling to comply with policy guidelines will not be permitted to remain on the community grounds. Hilton East will maintain documentation of all screening information which will include the visitor's first and last name, physical address, day and evening phone number, date and time of visit, and email if available. A notation that the visitor cleared the screening process will also be kept on file. No visitor will be permitted to enter or visit if they do not meet all criteria of the screening process.

Each area of visitation will be properly set up to maintain social distancing. Each area will be properly disinfected with an EPA-approved disinfectant before and after each visit. Visitation guidelines will be given to each visitor. Guidelines must be adhered to throughout the entire visit.

Hilton East will ensure there is adequate PPE for residents and visitors. Visitors may choose to wear their own mask or one will be provided to them. Masks must be worn at all times. Visitors will not be permitted anywhere in the facility except for the designated visitation area/areas. All visitations shall be suspended for a minimum of 28 days if a resident or employee has a positive COVID-19 test result. Any COVID positive resident will be denied any visitors and will be in quarantine for at least 14 days.

There will be a limit of 2 people per resident for the visit. In-house visits will be limited to a half-hour and will be on a first come first serve basis. Visitation days will be Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday between the hours of 1:00 pm and 8:00 pm.
